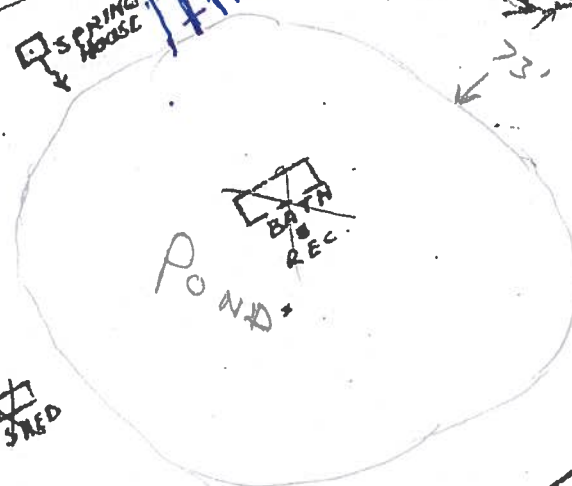

# Rough sketch and Explanation of work to be done.

As you can see in the attached picture, the wooden trough is slowly collapsing as a result of rot. Moreover, it is no longer watertight and leaks like a sieve. As a result, a lot of soil under it has eroded. The plan is to remove left of the trough, fill in the void created by erosion with large boulders, and then recreate a "trough" made out of stone which will last much longer than another made out of wood, but will also enhance the appearance of the pond, giving it a more natural look.
