**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF
LITCHFIELD, CHAPTER 8 "LICENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS
REGULATIONS", ARTICLE II "PEDDLERS, HAWKERS AND SOLICITORS"**

Section 1. Authority.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 7-148(c)(7)(H)(ii), 7-148(c)(7)(H)(iv) and 7-148(c)(7)(H)(xi), and Chapter 408.

Section 2. Amendments to Code of Ordinances.

The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Litchfield, Chapter 8, "Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations", Article II, "Peddlers, Hawkers and Solicitors", is amended as follows:

Sec. 8-30

Section 8-30, heretofore "Reserved", is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 8-30. Emergency Suspension of Permits and Licenses.

In the event of the declaration of a civil emergency, health emergency, or other emergency by the Governor of the State of Connecticut or by the Connecticut General Assembly, or in the event of a local emergency declared by the First Selectman or by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Litchfield pursuant to the General Statutes or any Executive Order(s) of the Governor of Connecticut, the licensing or permitting of peddlers, hawkers, and solicitors may be temporarily suspended by majority vote of the Board of Selectmen. Such suspension may be for a specified period or may be for the full duration that the declared emergency exists. Such action of the Board of Selectmen shall suspend already-issued licenses and permits and applications for licenses and permits."

Secs. 8-31 – 8-50

Sections 8-31 through 8-50 remain, "Reserved".

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication of a summary of its provisions in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes §7-157(b).
